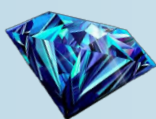

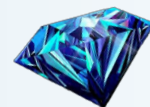

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

How the year has just rushed by to once again challenge us with the year 2017. The biggest challenge of all in 2017 will be presenting our **60th Diamond Anniversary Show 18th March** but more on that at a later date.

The 2016 year found us consolidating our Society with regular and effective committee meetings. Although a lot of discussion at these meetings centered around planning for our 2017 show, many other matters were tabled and considered during the year with notable matters being :

- safe towing of our trailer and compliance with regulations
- online banking
- investigation of developing a mobile phone friendly website
- invest in advertising material for shows, exhibitions i.e. banners, flags, bumper stickers
- selling our excess show cages
- review again of our Constitution
- Companion Animal Act Laws
- Siamese Diversity Project

A key event early 2016 was finally CCCA's recognition of Cats NSW now that it is a Full member of ACF having completed its probationary period. Thank you to those breeders who have tested their entires and provided results for Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA). Working together to gather information and manage this disease will remain an ongoing challenge for each and every one of us breeding our Siamese.

I must also congratulate our media administrators Peter Gunczy (website) and Sharon Black (Facebook) for their efforts in 2016. These two outlets are a key reason in not only promoting our Society but also in bringing customers to our breeders. 2016 has seen a resurgence in enquiries and sales for our "pure" Siamese and I am certain that many, if not all, of our breeder members have waiting lists for their kittens.

Congratulations and thank you to those members who enjoyed show success and as importantly exhibited and promoted our Siamese breed. The funniest feline moment this past year went like this:



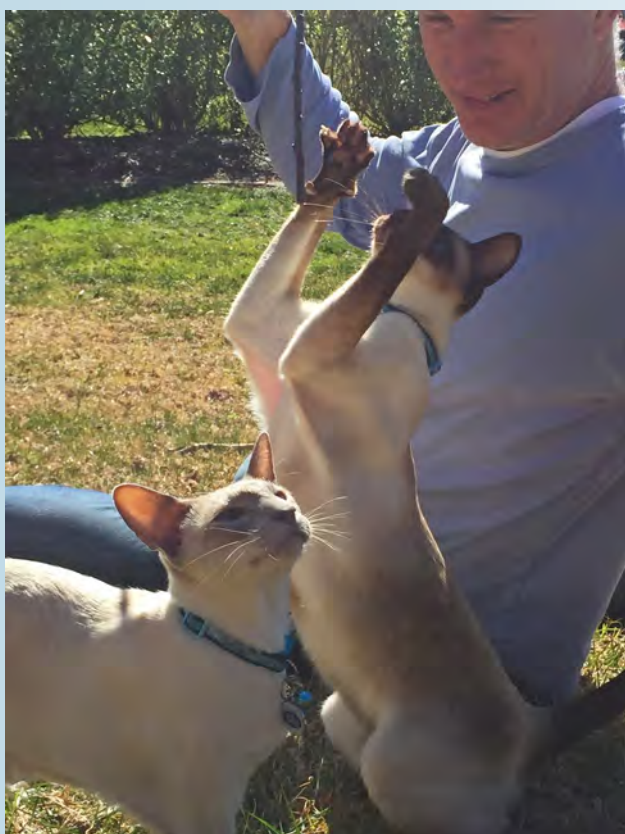
George, our Chocolate boy, wakes up for his portrait

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IMPORTANT NOTICE

CONSTITUTION CHANGES

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING SATURDAY 4th February, 2017

Resolution 1: At (a) (i) replace the wording “husbands and wives” as partners must be accommodated:
“Full Members shall be breeders or owners of Siamese cats, and their **husband, wife or defacto partner**, each living at the same address.”

Resolution 2: At 3 (b) add the wording **“from progressing to membership”** as better clarifies results of two negative votes:

3 (b): “All prospective members shall apply for membership on the form prescribed by the Committee and shall be elected by the Committee. Two negative votes in a secret ballot shall exclude **from progressing to membership**.”

Resolution 3: At 5 (d): The Honorary Treasurer (iv) add the word **“either”** and words **“or an original and most recent bank statement signed by a Justice of the Peace declaring the financial position of the Society”** thereby providing an alternative to the previous requirement for an audited statement:

5 (d) (iv) “Present **either** an audited statement of the financial position of the Society **or an original and most recent bank statement signed by a Justice of the Peace declaring the financial position of the Society** together with a report on the year’s financial activities to the Annual General Meeting.”

Resolution 4: At 5 (f) Replace **“shall”** with **“may”** removing the mandatory requirement of appointing an auditor:

5 (f) “The Society may appoint annually an auditor who may (notwithstanding the provisions of sub-clause (e) hereof) be a non member of the Society, but **may** be an officer of the Society. If an auditor resigns, or otherwise ceases to act.”

Resolution 5: At 6 (b) (vii) (A) add the words **“if required”** to compliment change at Resolution 4.

(vii) Election of:

(A) Auditors **if required**

Resolution 6: At 8 (b) add the words **“All electronic transactions debiting our Society banking account shall carry the authorisation of two out of the President, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer.”** To make provision for electronic banking:

8 (b) “A banking account shall be opened on behalf of the Society. All cheques drawn on behalf of the Society shall be signed by two out of the President, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer. **All electronic transactions debiting our Society banking account shall carry the authorisation of two out of the President, Honorary Secretary and Honorary Treasurer.**”

Resolution 7. At 12 (b) replace the wording **“New South Wales”** with **“N.S.W. Inc.”** thereby maintaining consistency through this document.

12 (b): “The expression **“The Society”** means **“The Siamese Cat Society of N.S.W. Inc.”**”

All proposals moved by Tony Hurry, seconded by John Ferguson.

Preparing Your Cat for the Show

You've finally decided to enter a cat show! You have a pedigreed kitten or cat that you are very proud of, and want to let others see him/her. Maybe your special cat can even win a ribbon or a title some day. Getting your cat ready for the show ring actually starts when they are a kitten. Putting the kitten in a small cage at home will help prepare it for the time it will spend at a show in close quarters. Playing the radio or television loudly can help prepare the kitten for the loud noises of a show hall. Start out gradually for short periods of time, and gradually increase the amount of time in the cage at home.

Remember that in order to be a good show cat, your kitten or cat needs to have a very mellow temperament, in addition to being a beautiful example of his/her breed. Try leaving your carrier out in your kitten's room (moving it from room to room occasionally), and then taking it for short trips in the car. If you only put your kitten or cat in the carrier and take it in the car when going to see the veterinarian, it is only natural that your feline will come to associate the carrier and the car with this unpleasant experience. Be sure your kitty is always safely within a clean carrier whenever you take it in the car. When bringing your kitten or cat to a show, never line the carrier with newspaper as the newsprint may stain your cat!!

Grooming and General Care

Any cat should be groomed regularly, but special preparation is often done in the two weeks immediately prior to a show. There are many different types of grooming devices on the market today such as grooming mits or gloves, soft brushes, various types of steel combs etc. Short-haired cats will benefit greatly from being groomed regularly with the right type of brush. A brush that is too soft is not going to remove very much of the loose top coat, a steel comb or "wire" type brush is

better as it helps to promote good circulation, ensuring healthy skin as well as removing the loose top coat. Cats often don't enjoy being groomed by us initially, so it is a good idea to get your cat used to this from as early as possible. Grooming your cat on a regular basis will remove any loose fur that could end up in the cat's digestive system. This may cause constipation, fur balls, and discomfort that can also result in your cat throwing up on a regular basis.

Of course the best way to have your cat at his/her best is to have it be in the best of health, and always feed it a top quality scientifically formulated diet. Some cats seem to need more nutrients than others, and a good supplement may also be helpful. Do not ever try to bring a cat to a show that is not in the best of health. Not only will your cat not do well, but by exposing your cat to all the other cats at a show when perhaps it's immune system is run down, you increase the chances that it could become quite ill, or even infect others. Always be sure that your cat is up to date on all shots, including rabies shots. Regular grooming and good nutrition will ensure that your cat has a nice shiny coat, few problems with constipation and fur balls, and less chance of getting any other skin related problems.

Is my cat clean?

Oriental, Burmese and Siamese cats can be given a bran bath two days before a show; this often makes the coat gleam as it removes dirt and excess grease. To give a bran bath, a cup of plain bran should be warmed thoroughly in a moderate oven. The bran should then be rubbed with your fingers against the natural growth direction of the coat, left on for a few minutes, then gently brushed out with a slicker wire brush. White or light coloured short-haired cats may benefit from a little talcum powder, but again, all traces of the powder must be removed

before the show. Some short-haired cats do not need a full bath but have grubby areas such as unwashed noses or feet, chin acne or greasy tails. Pay special attention to these areas before a show to be sure they are spotlessly clean. There are also quite a few products on the market for giving extra sheen to the coat – be sure to experiment with them long before an important show to find out which products work best for your own cat.

Ears and eyes

Gently clean your cat's ears with sterile cotton buds or Q-tips, being careful not to probe deeply. You just want to remove any unsightly dust or wax. If you notice a lot of wax build up or debris, it is quite possible that your cat has ear mites. These need to be treated by your veterinarian with medication. Gently cleanse the eyes from inner side to outer side with a clean cotton pad or Baby wipe.

Claws

It is mandatory before a show that each cat have all their nails trimmed (all four paws). Be sure you have a high quality nail trimming scissors - it does make a big difference in the accuracy and speed with which you can trim your cat's nails. Press gently on the top of each toe to push the nail forward out of its sheath. Clip just the sharp tip of the nail, and be sure to avoid the "quick" area which contains the nerves and blood vessels (it's easy to see as it is pink, while the tip of the nail is clear). Try to cut all the nails in one session, but if the cat struggles it is better to give it a little treat, and try again later in the day. Eventually you will have all nails trimmed, and if you still just can't do it, your vet or vet tech can do this for you before an important show. SECRETARY'S REPORT

Good afternoon everyone. Our year as a Society has been a very interesting one to say the least.

We had an awesome **Siamese Cat Society 59th Show in 2016**, which was held at Wollondilly Shire Hall last February and was a huge success, even though not so much monetarily (it was not expected, but definitely hoped for.) Our Treasurer can elaborate further on that in her report.

Our committee was kept very busy through that wonderful show and things were full steam ahead for all. Our little band of volunteers went above and beyond to make this show the huge success that it was, so thanks to all who helped in setting up, and in dismantling the show afterwards.

We at **Fullcircle Siamese Cattery** were very honoured to have achieved the Pure Siamese Breeder's pinnacle award for a cattery, as the **winner of the Joyce Selby Award, for BEST PURE SIAMESE**. We were also the fortunate recipients of the **L J Hooker Picton/Fullcircle Siamese Award for THE BEST PURE SIAMESE KITTEN OR CAT BRED BY THE EXHIBITOR**. (John loved winning our \$100 prize back!!).

We are hoping that our next **60th Diamond Anniversary Siamese Cat Society Show** will be an even bigger hit. It will be held at **Bargo Sports Club** on 18th March, 2017.

I am afraid I dropped the ball big time last year. As Secretary, I can only thank Tony Hurry for coming to my aid following the problems we faced. Many thanks Tony, you are an awesome friend and Mentor. Then also as EDITOR when our little band of family – John Ferguson, Brooke Hilton and myself (and not forgetting our once beautiful Office of **L J Hooker PICTON**) – were totally devastated.

Thankfully our home and our precious animals were all spared from the "Super-Storm." It wiped out PICTON and its entire business sector with some 300 plus claims on that

shocking day and night, but our home here in WILTON suffered no damage.

I hope to never repeat this past year as I really don't think my nerves or my health could stand it.

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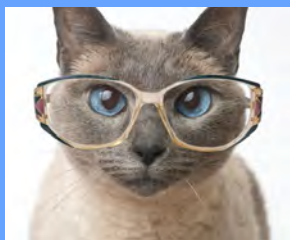
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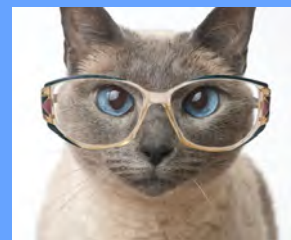

Special Report

Feline Panleukopenia virus

An outbreak of **feline panleukopenia virus (FPV)** has occurred in New South Wales. This has been described by the media release below by the Australian Veterinary Association. The facts are as follows:

- ◆ The current F3 vaccine provides protection from the disease
- ◆ Unvaccinated kittens are most susceptible to the disease.
- ◆ There is currently no requirement for exhibitors to provide vaccination certificates for adult cats, however, from our May show we will be requiring exhibitors to provide current vaccination certificates for all exhibits.
- ◆ We will further be recommending that kittens attending shows should have at least two vaccinations for their own protection.
- ◆ At the February show we will be providing hand sanitising facilities for exhibitors and members of the public and signage to encourage its use.
- ◆ As with many diseases, cats may be contagious before they show any symptoms.

We encourage all exhibitors to catch up on their vaccinations where they have let them lapse. Vaccination protocols vary from vet to vet but to be current the due date on the vaccination certificate should not have been passed.

We understand most of you have your cats confined and potentially away from risk of this disease, but wandering cats may enter your property and have some contact.

While it is too late to get additional vaccinations before the show on Saturday, you should be mindful of some additional risk.

Most importantly, if you have any cats or kittens in your home displaying any symptoms of illness, please do not attend any show.

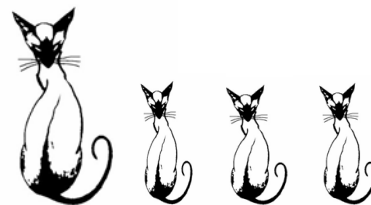
